High Street Veterans Modernization Update July 28, 2026

You have noticed the construction going on around your building, with construction equipment all over the site, pathways dug up, and trenches around the upper playground. This notice explains the two major projects going on at High Street Vets and previews impacts for residents.

Master Meter/Stove Electrification

This project upgrades building electrical service and will install new electric stoves in every apartment. Right now, contractors are digging trenches to lay electrical conduit between buildings. They are currently working in the upper playground area and will start digging in parking lots soon. Once complete, they will start installing stoves in early fall.

Please take care and avoid areas where the electrification contractors are working!

Site Improvements

This project will make big improvements to site walkways, playgrounds, parking lots, and landscaping. The project will:

- Replace walkways so people can move around more easily;
- Fix or replace broken concrete steps and handrails;

- Replace and reconfigure the Chestnut Street parking lot;
- Install a new small playground on the upper triangle for children ages 2–5 with safe ground surfacing;
- Remove the deteriorated “tot lot” on north edge of development;
- Add new site furniture such as benches and tables; and
- Plant new trees, remove dead trees, and reseed areas impacted by digging.

We hope to complete all this work by the end of the fall construction season.

Impacts on residents:

- Parking disruptions – mostly during working hours. The town of Brookline will allow overnight street parking for HSV residents while parking lots are under construction;
- Flowers and vegetable plantings: BHA cannot coordinate all digging between contractors and residents. If you have any plants growing outside you wish to keep, please remove them as soon as possible;
- Noise from construction equipment; and
- Temporary loss of access to parts of grounds or walkways.

Please take care and avoid areas where the contractors are working!

Contractors should only operate heavy machinery between 8am-4pm. If you find that contractors are starting early, or you have any other concerns about the project, please **Contact Akil Alexander, Capital Projects Manager.**
